## **Tack & Turnout, How To Submit Test & Results**

### **How to upload your video submission**

Youtube – Videos can be uploaded to youtube, you can upload it as Unlisted if you would like no one else to be able to see your entry. Please add your entry as the title (for example 'Joe Bloggs & Teddy – Intro 1 Entry') Once you have uploaded your video to Youtube, please send us the link via email at [cashdressageonline@gmail.com](mailto:cashdressageonline@gmail.com)

Whatsapp – You can Whatsapp by sending the video link to us at 07429747470, please include in your message details of your submission (for example 'Joe Bloggs & Teddy – Intro 1 Restricted section Entry').

### **Tack & Turnout(In all classes apart from our 'Relaxed Rules' section)**

Show attire is not required, but gloves must be worn. If you are not wearing gloves you will be deducted 2 points.

Riding hats must be worn. Suitable footwear with a heel and gloves must be worn for safety reasons. Boots and bandages are allowed to be worn

Bridles– For Introductory, Preliminary and Novice tests – ordinary snaffle bridle; Elementary and above – ordinary snaffle or double bridle. Nosebands must be worn, a drop, cavesson, grackle or flash with a snaffle or a cavesson with a double bridle.

Bits – BD permitted bits only, to find out if your bit/bridle is BD legal please check out this biting guide issued by BD: <https://www.britishdressage.co.uk/media/2578/bd-approved-tack-equipment-and-clothing-1-dec-2020.pdf>

Other tack - martingales, side, running or elasticised reins may not be used in any competition class

Neck straps or balancing straps (a loop on the front of the saddle) may be used at all levels. Cruppers are also allowed.

Spurs and a whip may also be used

**If you are wearing any non BD legal tack - your test will still be marked but you will not be eligible for placings(unless in the Relaxed Rules class)**

## **Results**

The judges decisions are final. No communication or discussion will be considered. Any objection or appeal regarding a score must be made in writing within 24 hours of the test being judged.

Very rarely mistakes may be made with calculating percentages, please ensure we are notified by email within 24 hours of receipt of your test sheet and we will endeavour to rectify any errors.

Rosettes will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> place in all of our classes

Results will be posted on our Facebook Page following the deadline, score sheets will be delivered electronically via email from [cashdressageonline@gmail.com](mailto:cashdressageonline@gmail.com). We aim to have these to you within 1 week of results, any rosettes and prizes will be posted as soon as possible.
